

National Funeral Exhibition (NFE) Competition 2026 – Terms & Conditions (T&Cs)

The Prize is a £500 hotel voucher with options for golf/spa resorts at a UK-based hotel up to a maximum value of £500 which will be funded by the Promoter. The voucher will be presented to the Winner who is responsible for making the booking.

1. Should the hotel accommodation charge be less than the Prize value, then hotel meals/drinks, use of the hotel spa/golf facilities (if applicable) may be able to be included subject to the T&Cs: <https://www.buyagift.co.uk/terms> and hotel T&Cs. No cash alternative will be given for any remaining balance value. Once the voucher budget has been reached, any extra costs must be covered by the Winner. In accepting the Prize, the Winner agrees to comply with the T&Cs of the Prize provider, for example, and any T&Cs the hotel may provide.
2. The Promoter will not be responsible in the event that the Winner is unable to utilise the Prize prior to the Prize voucher expiry date and no alternative Prize or timeframe will be offered. The Winner may wish to consider adding hotel booking insurance at the time of making arrangements, or checking if other insurance options cover this.

4. Entry to the Competition is free and is based on achieving a hole-in-one on the manned golf event. No purchase is necessary.
5. Only one entry per person is allowed based on three attempts at a hole-in-one and their badge scanned during the course of National Funeral Exhibition (NFE) 2026. Entries will be screened for duplication.

Golf hole-in-one attempts must be verified by an Ecclesiastical Planning Services staff member and entries to the draw made by placing a business card or completed entry form in the designated receptacle on the Promoter's stand at NFE 2026 and a badge scan which will trigger a £1 donation to the Macmillan Cancer Support charity, up to a maximum value of £750, as advertised on the Promoter's NFE stand.
7. The Competition is open to all UK-based funeral directors, their staff and NFE badge holders who are 18 years of age or over.
8. Entry into the Competition confirms acceptance of these T&Cs.

The Competition is not open to employees or contractors of the Promoter and its corporate group of companies, or to any person directly or indirectly involved with the organising of the Competition or the organizing of the Promoters stand or the Promoter's business. 10. The Promoter reserves the right to disqualify late, incomplete, altered or illegible entries. No communication, including communication of disqualification, will be provided.

The Winner will be selected from eligible entrants who achieve a verified hole-in-one within three attempts at the golf competition on the Ecclesiastical Planning Services exhibition stand at NFE 2026. To be eligible, entrants must have their hole-in-one verified by an Ecclesiastical Planning Services staff member, have their badge scanned, and have submitted a valid business card or completed entry form into the designated collection receptacle. Where more than one entrant achieves a verified hole-in-one, the Winner will be chosen by random draw from all eligible entries.
12. The Winner will be drawn and notified by telephone or email at 4.30pm on Saturday 13 June 2026. Voice messages will be left in the event that it is not possible to speak to the Winner. Afterwards, we will make four further attempts to contact the Winner and if we do not hear from the Winner before 5pm 31 August 2026, then the Prize will expire and a new winner will be drawn.
13. The Promoter is obliged by the ASA CAP Code to make available information that indicates a valid award has been made. By submitting your entry, should you win, the Promoter will make available upon request your surname and county of residence.
14. By entering the Competition, you agree to the Promoter sharing your name, firm name and county of residence for the Promoter's promotional emails to its funeral director network and social media.
15. The Promoter's liability under or in connection with these T&Cs shall be limited to the value of the Prize. The Promoter shall not be responsible for any loss, damage, liability or disappointment incurred or suffered by you as a result of entering the Competition, to the extent that it is permitted by law and unless caused by the Promoter's willful negligence.
